



Q3 3. Are you male or female?





Q4 4. Are you aged 55 or over?


















Q12 12. CHILD CARE AND CHILD DEVELOPMENTWhich child care and/or child development needs could you or your family use help with... (select all that apply)







Deep cleaning after a furnace blowout. Took over a month and it's not even finished. 3A wants me 5/18/2017 3:05 PM to call on some problems I've encountered and I'm already on disability for several conditions.

to call on some problems I've encountered and I'm already on disability for several conditions, including major depression, extreme anxiety, and constant physical pain. I just can't call who they contracted to do the job and have him bill for what he did clean and end his contract and then call the cleaning lady I found while the first crew took off for 2 weeks and also call a carpet and upholstery cleaner to do that once the house has been cleaned of all debris that was blown out of every vent in every room. The blowout was January 11,2017 and as much as I appreciate the financial help since I am stretched thin that area, I would feel better if everything was cleaned up. The original cleaners told me to get someone else if I wanted to since they would be gone for 3 weeks but when I told 3A in Decorah they said the contract was with the first provider. She said she wished she had written it up differently but for me to call them and have them complete the job. I'm worried cuz they only cleaned the basement and part of the dining room which I estimated to be \$486 and the funding is for only \$1000. I can smell old dirt and dust in my carpet and furniture but I don't see how this steam cleaning will get done based on his rates and the slowness of cleaning that's been done by his teenage children. I needed someone to handle this and navigate through any issues on my behalf. I'm afraid to call the 3A lady back because I don't want to appear to be a difficult and ungrateful person. So I just haven't called anyone. A local agency is providing in-home services but they don't seem to want to do housework which would help get things cleaned up faster. The lack of progress has increased my depression and I still feel overwhelmed. They're saying it's hard to get C-dac(sp?) services but the county case worker knows I'm in constant pain, on 3 different pain meds, have severe diabetic foot pain, have arthritis that interferes with walking and writing and I thought she said I would get the cleaning help, which I've had trouble keeping up with so all was rather dusty and dirty even before the furnace blowout. All of this just adds to my feeling of hopelessness. The local services agency also knows I need someone to mow the lawn, trim various foliage, and use a weed eater on several areas. My lawn is now a foot tall and I still haven't heard back from the supervisor on this. Everything is just getting worse instead of better. I need a sewer pipe repair that is expensive and I can't afford. Consequently I don't put toilet paper down the toilet for fear it will backup again in the basement which is very gross. It's also gross to have to put urine soaked toilet paper in the trash. I'm embarrassed and feel unclean. To me it's a health hazard but I don't know what else to do. A really nice guy who owns a sewer service company has cleared the pipe about 3 times and did not charge me. He explained the problem and feels the city should pay for it. But they refused. I started putting the tp in the bathroom trash in hopes that I could stop the backups and stop having to call him cuz I feel bad that he keeps doing it for free. My teeth are in bad shape. One tooth is cracked and I'm missing most of my chewing teeth. My diabetes is out of control because I'm eating soft foods that aren't good for keeping my blood sugars down or my diabetes. My gums get sore and become red, torn and painful when I try to eat the healthier foods. I have some bone granulation problems and an off-bite that's so bad it's worn away critical areas of my teeth. I think I can get partial dentures but the local dentist said a deformity in the roof of my mouth is another big problem. I was referred to the U of I Dental School but I wasn't able to get myself there, the said it could take 3-4 trips just for the evaluation and that they don't have a sliding fee scale. I couldn't afford the gas back and forth, my car sounds like it's falling apart, and I felt I couldn't possibly afford the dental work. I'm very self conscious about my teeth and I'm embarrassed by them. These are just some of the issues I need help with. The main ones probably. Thank you



Q22 21. In the last 12 months, how has your household's income situation changed?





Q23 22. What time of day would you prefer to come to one of our locations (offices) for assistance?







Q25 24. Is your current housing adequate for your family size?





Q26 25. How important is it to you that you have a local (in your county) NEICAC Family Service Office to access NEICAC services?





Q27 26. Would your pre-school/childcare needs be met if your child was not enrolled in Head Start?





Q28 27. Is your household currently receiving any type of assistance with your rent?












