



NEICAC-EARL PUBLIC TRANSIT RIDER'S GUIDE

To make a reservation, call 866-382-4259 or 563-382-4259. TDD/TTY users may place a reservation by calling RELAY IOWA: 800-735-2942.

We need the following information to accurately schedule your ride:

- Appointment time of Medical Appointment/Work Arrival or Pick up time
- Pick-Up Address
- Drop-Off Address
- Is return ride needed?
- Will anyone be riding with you to assist you to get in/out of vehicle or assist you in getting to your appointment?
- Will you need door to door service?
- Will you need to use the lift to enter/exit the vehicle?

The bus will arrive in a window of time, you are provided this information when your ride is confirmed by our reservation staff. Please be ready to board the bus.

CANCELLATIONS MUST BE PHONED IN. FAILING TO CALL WILL BE CONSIDERED A "NO SHOW". No shows may result in a suspension or termination of service.

Drivers are not authorized to make unscheduled stops. Any change in your scheduled ride must be called into the office first.

Drivers won't enter a facility to find a passenger.

Always use Handrails when Boarding or Exiting the vehicle.

Use the seatbelt and remain seated during the trip.

Service Animals are welcome to ride with you.

Be Courteous to the Driver and other passengers.

Do not eat or drink while onboard the vehicle.

Dispose of all trash appropriately.

Limit Carry-on bags/materials to what you can handle without assistance.

THE POSSESSION OF DANGEROUS OR UNAUTHORIZED MATERIALS, SUCH AS EXPLOSIVES, FIREARMS, GUNS, OR KNIVES IS FORBIDDEN.

In-town - \$2.00 (one way) In-town services are scheduled in Cresco, Decorah, Elkader, Guttenberg, Oelwein, Waukon, and West Union.

Out of town trips - \$2.00/mile
