Early Childhood Programs

All Head Start & Early Head Start children receive books through the Dolly Parton Imagination Library. The books are mailed right to the registered child's address monthly! This is thanks to a generous funder.



FaDSS

In the current program year, six families have exited. 67% of those families increased their income from enrollment to exit. They had over 1,600 contacts & 144 visits with FaDSS Specialists.

The State's annual report shows the Weatherization Assistance Program results across Iowa.

CACFP

In December, the CACFP program provided over 6,400 meals to ten centers with 16 classrooms.



Transit

In December, the Transit program drove a collective 239,580 hours and completed 1,050 trips! 54 new customers were served for a total of 479 unduplicated customers throughout the month!
