Winter moratorium protection ended on April 1, 2023, NEICAC approved over \$370,000 in assistance to help 370 households regain or maintain electric, natural gas, or oil services.

Family Services

In April, NEICAC received 3,000 pounds of food donations to our Food Pantries and distributed nearly 9,000 pounds of food to 151 households. We assisted 10 households with rent payments to prevent housing loss.



Transit

In April, Transit had 42 brand new customers that utilized our services! Transit also completed 5,667 trips, including 1,030 trips for medical appointments and/or dialysis.



Weatherization

14 homes were Weatherized in April. The program also received the WAP Retrofit Guide which is an illustrated guide for the weatherization process. This will be a great training tool moving forward!



FaDSS

In April, 44 families were served and FaDSS staff completed 35 home/quality visits. 57% of those home visits engaged 2 or more members of the household. 46 collaborative contacts were made on behalf of families.
