Family Services

Nearly 700 separate households were served through NEICAC Outreach Offices across our seven county service area in June with over \$130,000 of assistance approved to help meet needs.



Transit

In June, our Transit drivers logged over 43,000 miles and almost 5,000 trips - all while keeping a 96% on-time performance rate!



CACFP

We provided 1,223 meals and 754 snacks to kids in the Head Start summer wrap program in June! We also welcomed a new in-home provider in Fayette County.



Early Childhood Programs

Fifteen families (65 people) who are enrolled in Early Head Start took a trip to the Dubuque River Museum in June!



Weatherization

Ten homes were completed in June & staff received extensive training at the IWAC Retreat on combustion & home pressures.



Of the families that exited FaDSS, 64% had increased income & 88% of those with children ages 0-5 were co-enrolled in early childhood programs.



In the past year, our Housing program has provided housing to 110 household members and 63 households.
