Weatherization

We received the SLICE (Statewide Low-Income Collaborative Effort) report for 2022, which is the performance report for all the WAP departments in the state. We were pleased to be one of the top agencies for dollars saved annually per household with an average savings of \$622.00/household. This was the second highest in the state of lowa with the top agency at \$635.00/household. NEICAC's average cost per household was \$12,494.00-which is the lowest cost in the state! This compares to the top saving agency spending almost \$29,000.00 per household. Hats off to the NEICAC's WAP staff for another outstanding year!
